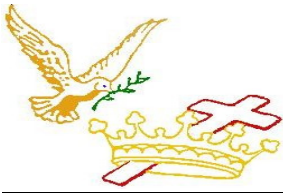

On Friday, January 23rd, many of the women of Bal Perazim came together with an understanding that we each possess power; but we left with an even greater understanding that together, we possess the power that can change attitudes, hearts, and even the world! Our attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus (Phil. 2:5 NIV). These spirits (pride, control, gossip, rebellion, manipulation, and envy) hover over us; but when we allow them to operate, they become overwhelming. These "no-harm" weights are anything but! "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places (Eph. 6:12)." Pride is an unduly high opinion of oneself. "An high look, and a proud heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin (Prov. 21:4)." God would have us to be humble with a contrite spirit. When we listen to or repeat rumors, we help to degrade others. Rather than spreading the *Gospel*, we choose to spread *gossip*. The Word of God instructs us to "Rejoice with them that do rejoice... (Rom. 12:15);" instead, we become envious of them, desiring the blessing they have, over what God has blessed us with. These are spirits that Satan, our enemy, wants us to pickup, and put down the fruits of the spirit. Apart, we can fight. Together, we can fight better!

GROWTH, CHARACTER AND ORGANIZATION of the CHURCH

Here is what we have been learning in
Sunday School at BP:

In the beginning of the church, there was no clergy. This and other offices were created as the need arose. Just as kings, judges, and generals came into existence to meet the needs of civil society, so the clergy developed to meet the needs and responsibilities of the growing church.

While the institution of the office of elder is not definitely sated in Scripture, it was so well known and understood that it is believed to have been the familiar mode of governing the Jewish synagogues (Matt. 15:2). The apostles were called elders (1 Pet. 5:1), but as their number was limited to those who had seen the Lord Jesus after his resurrection (Acts 1:21, 22), they soon passed off the scene. The elders were also called bishops or overseers (Titus 1:5, 7). The former was a name more familiar to the Jewish convert, but the latter to the Gentile. The elders were often distinguished pastors (Eph. 4:11) to emphasize the fact that they were the divinely appointed shepherds who were to "feed the flock of God." They were the appointed teachers and spiritual guides in the early Christian church.

COPY THE MASTER!

The Louvre in Paris is perhaps the most famous art museum in the world. It displays originals by such masters as Delacroix, Michelangelo, Rubens, da Vinci, Ingres, Vermeer, and many others. Since 1973, the Louvre has encouraged aspiring artists to come and copy the masters. Some of our most famous modern artists have done that and have become better painters by copying the best the world has ever known.

An article in Smithsonian magazine tells about Amal Dagher, a 63-year old man who has been duplicating art at the Louvre for 30 years. Dagher remains in awe of the masters and continues to learn from them. He said, "If you're too satisfied with yourself, you can't improve." Paul instructed us to be "imitators of God" (Ephesians 5:1). In his first letter to the Thessalonians, he commended the believers because they were becoming like the Lord and setting an example for others (1 Thes. 1:6-10).

Like the Louvre copyists, we'll never reach perfection before we get to heaven. Even so, we must resist the temptation to be satisfied with our present imitation of Jesus. We need to keep looking to Him, learning from Him, and asking for His help. Let's copy the Master!
