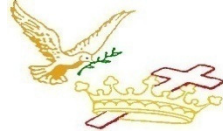

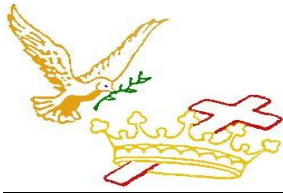

MINISTRY OF ANGELS

Here is what we have been learning in
Sunday school at BP:

Angels are perfect in character. Every
angel renders consecrated service of
praise to God (Ps. 148:2). Angels are
at the same time both worshipers of
God and servants of men (Heb. 1:14).
Angels provide comfort to God's
people, such as they did to Paul when
he was shipwrecked (Acts 27:23, 24).
Angels are often employed by God to
throw into the hearts of His people
comforting thoughts. Angels come and
minister unto us just as they did to
Jesus; although few of us have enough
belief in the existence of angels.

Angels also fulfill a protective ministry
over God's people. They are also shown
as the protectors of the nation of
Israel (Exod. 14:19; 23:20) and of
Daniel (6:22). These portions of
Scripture indicate God's great love.
What greater blessing can the believer
receive than the protection from
danger by God's angels?

Several times it was evident that
angels delivered the apostles from
persecution during their ministry.
When the Jews imprisoned Peter and
some of the other apostles, an angel
came by night, opened the jail doors,
and led them out (Acts 5:17-19).

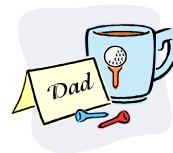
