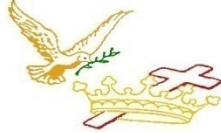

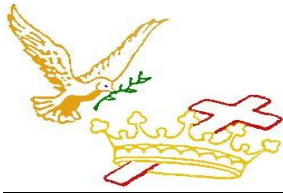

**MORE CHARACTERISTICS  
OF ANGELS**

Here is what we have been learning in  
Sunday School at BP:

Angels in their unfallen state are completely pure. They are in a state of established and superior holiness, and are not tempted with evil. Their refusal to receive worship from humans is evident of this. Their whole nature abhors that which is evil. Their moral perfection is shown by such phrases as "holy angels" and "the elect angels." Angels are glorious beings; they are powerful, humble and obedient. Every angel has a ministry. Every angel renders consecrated service to God (Ps. 148:2). Angels are, at the same time, both worshipers of God and servants of God (Hebr. 1:14). The Lord set forth this truth when He said that the angels of children ever behold the face of the Father in heaven (Matt. 18:10).

Angels sometimes appeared to God's people to announce his plan, for their lives, or to direct the work he had for them to do. Angels are deeply interested in the Christian's work. In the cases of Peter and Cornelius, an angel guided the Christian worker to the sinner and the sinner to the Christian worker, and watched over their relationship. Angels rejoice each time a sinner repents and returns to God.
