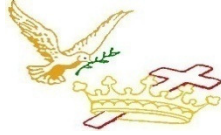

Apostle's Communique:

The Good News in Bal Perazim is that it's **Forgiveness** time! We are still "Living in the Land of Goshen," in "The House that God Built;" and God desires for us to forget and forgive. To forget means to lose the facts or knowledge about something from the mind; or fail to recall; it also means to overlook, omit, or neglect intentionally. To forgive means to give up resentment of; or grant a relief or pardon for. This is exactly what Joseph did when his brothers, who were jealous of him, threw him in a pit and later sold him into slavery in Egypt (Gen. 45). Regardless of Joseph's brothers' actions, Joseph was pulled out of the pit and eventually placed in a position of power and prestige in Pharaoh's palace. Joseph understood that God was carrying out His will through the brother's actions, and forgave them. He knew that God was positioning him to save his family from the famine throughout Canaan and Egypt. God was making provisions all along! He wants us in the Land of Goshen!

Now is the time for God to dig up (and deliver us from) our dead issues; the things that we have kept buried all of this time. Like Joseph's brothers, when we keep our sins and misdeeds buried, they begin to gnaw at us, eating away at our core, leaving us weak and open to attack. This unforgiveness matures into hatred, and hatred and anger will make us give up our covenant relationship with God. This is not God's desire for us. Yes, Satan will bring it back up to us; but we must tell him to take it up with Jesus, because forgiveness has already been loosed. The Bible declares in Matthew 18:18, that whatever we loose on Earth, shall be loosed in Heaven. Forgiveness is attainable (with God)!

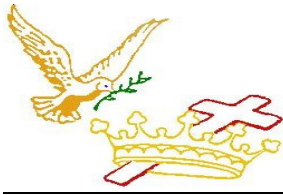

THE CHALLENGE of FORGIVENESS

In the heat of an argument, my wife came up with an acute theological insight. We were discussing my shortcomings in a rather spirited way when she said, "I think it's pretty amazing that I forgive you for some of the dastardly things you've done!"

What struck me about her comment was its sharp perception into the nature of forgiveness. It is not a sweet platonic ideal to be dispersed in the world like air-freshener sprayed from a can. Forgiveness is achingly difficult, and long after you've forgiven, the wound lives on in memory. Forgiveness is an unnatural act, and my wife was protesting its blatant unfairness.

A story from Genesis captures much the same sentiment. The brothers that Joseph struggled to forgive were the very ones who had bullied him, had cooked up schemes to murder him, and had sold him into slavery. Though he went on to triumph over adversity and though with all his heart he now wanted to forgive these brothers, he could not bring himself to that point—*not yet.*

I view Genesis 42–45 as Joseph's way of saying, "I think it's pretty amazing that I forgive you for the dastardly things you've done!" When grace finally broke through, the sound of Joseph's grief and love echoed through the palace. What was that wail? It was the sound of a man forgiving.

We can stop forgiving others when Christ stops forgiving us!

THE ANGEL OF THE LORD

Here is what we have been learning in
Sunday school at BP:

The Angel of the Lord in the Old Testament is a mysterious messenger of God. The Lord used this heavenly emissary to appear to human beings who otherwise would not be able to see Him and live (Ex. 33:20). The Angel of the Lord performed actions associated with God, such as revelation, deliverance, and God's judgment. While similar in nature to other angels, the Angel of the Lord occupies a higher station in heaven than angels in general.

The Angel of the Lord appeared to the following Old Testament personalities and performed the following actions on God's behalf:

Abraham- Prevented him from sacrificing his son Isaac (Gen 16:7-10);
Israel- Prepared the children of Israel to enter the Promised Land (Ex 23: 20-23);
Three Hebrew Men- Protected these young Israelites from Nebuchadnezzar's fiery furnace in Babylon (Dan 3:25).

In the New Testament: Peter- Released Peter from prison (Acts 12:7); Joseph- Assured Joseph of Mary's purity; warned him of Herod's plot; told Joseph about Herod's death. Angels operate to establish God's kingdom on Earth.

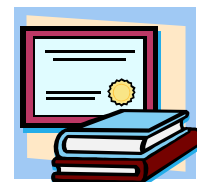
