Here is what we have been learning in  
Sunday School at BP:

The Christian church was founded on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2:1), when the Holy Spirit moved in a wonderful way in the hearts of men. The marvelous events that followed and that form the account of the earliest history of the church are, in reality, the acts of the Holy Spirit (Acts 4:31; 5:32; 13:2; 16:6). 17:6, 11, 14, 16). The message of the church is that it holds three fundamental beliefs: Jesus is Messiah, Jesus rose from the dead, and Jesus will return. All the disciples gave witness that Jesus of Nazareth was the long expected Messiah of Israel who died, rose again, and is exalted at God's right hand. Each member of the church was, and is expected to give personal loyalty, reverence, and obedience to Him as Savior. Christ's resurrection was proof of His Deity and evidence that God accepted His atonement for our sin and appointed Him to judge the world in righteousness. Christ's expected reign is the hope of all Believers!
